

## **GUIDELINES FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF MATERIALS FEES**

Policy 3250 requires that the Superintendent of Schools develop guidelines for materials for which students may be charged fees. .

### **Elementary (K-5)**

Parents are expected to purchase a range of supplies normally associated with school. These include such items as notebooks and paper, pencils, pens, crayons, assignment pads, etc. In addition, parents are expected to provide sneakers for physical education classes and students in grades 4 and 5 purchase a physical education shirt for approximately \$7 and shorts for approximately \$8. Other elementary parental purchase includes a recorder for music classes in grade three (\$4). Musical instrument rental is also available for some instruments (\$50 annually).

### **Middle School (6-8)**

In addition to a range of personal school supplies normally associated with middle school (refer to grade level supply lists), parents are expected to provide a PE uniform and sneakers. A PE lock can be purchased from the staff. Fees for bowling range from \$8-\$10 for the unit (the PE staff will contact parents prior to the unit beginning). Some courses, such as Family and Consumer Sciences, Technology and Art have a fee associated with consumable supplies (\$3 per course) and an additional fee for students whose projects extend beyond student required supplies. Grade 6 students will be charged a \$3.00 fee for their exploration of the three languages. For grade 8 Science a review book will be needed (\$9) and for grade 8 Accelerated Math a review book will be needed (\$8). The fee for a music locker will be \$4. A computer fee will be charged to each student for consumable computer supplies. Computer disks can be purchased separately in the library on a need basis for \$.50.

### **High School (9-12)**

In addition to a range of personal school supplies normally associated with a high school program, parents are expected to pay fees associated with the following courses:

**Math:** All courses may require ruler and compass (\$2), computer science (\$4/half year), graph paper (\$1.50). All math classes require a T183+/T184 calculator (\$120).

**Science:** Specimens for dissection in Biology (\$8). Advanced Placement Biology (\$20). Chemical Use fee (\$8). Science Research Class Fee (\$15). Global Science (\$8). Advanced Placement Environmental Science (\$15). Physical Science (\$8). Earth Science (\$8).

**Physical Education:** Athletic shoes, athletic supporter for boys, bathing caps for girls. Bowling class fee \$12-\$15. Bowling is optional. There is a \$20 charge for Red Cross Lifeguard Certification if sought.

**Music:** Instrumental rental fee (\$50).

**Related Arts:** Students will be expected to pay for materials they choose to use in the construction of projects which go beyond course requirements. These costs will vary with the project selected. An annual fee for consumable supplies will be charged to students in the following courses (half the fee for a semester course):
