

## **SENIOR CITIZEN IDENTIFICATION CARD**

**P1223**

Senior citizens have played a major role in the development of a sound school system in a progressive community and should be recognized for their contributions. Accordingly, any resident of the Burnt Hills-Ballston Lake School District who has reached his 60th birthday or who is receiving retirement disability pay may apply at the district office for a non-transferable Senior Citizen Identification Card.

This non-transferable identification card will entitle the senior citizen to free admission to all district-sponsored school events. These events shall include all "home" inter-scholastic athletic events, concerts, plays, talent shows, use of the pool, etc. In addition, the identification card will permit the senior citizen to enroll free of charge in all continuing education courses that have sufficient paid enrollment to permit the course to operate on a self-supporting basis. The Senior Citizen Identification Card is available at the District Office.
