

SALARY DEDUCTIONS

The Board of Education is authorized to make certain deductions from the salaries of its employees. Mandatory deductions include federal, state and local taxes as well as Social Security payments. Pursuant to written authorization of the employee, deductions may be made for union dues, agency shop fees, group health, accident and life insurance premiums, the purchase of annuities, flexible benefit programs authorized under Section 125 of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code, United Way Fund contributions, and payments to a credit union. Fines imposed upon employees as the result of District disciplinary proceedings, or authorized court ordered garnishment also may be deducted from employees' pay checks.
