

SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

P3100

1. The Chief Administrator of the school system will be called the Superintendent of Schools.
2. The Superintendent of Schools will be appointed by a majority vote of the Board of Education to a contract of not less than three nor more than five years as stipulated by Section 1711(3) of the Education Law.
3. The administration of the school system in all its aspects is the responsibility of the Superintendent of Schools, who will carry out his/her administrative functions in accord with the policies adopted by the Board of Education. The Superintendent of Schools is responsible for the implementation of all decisions made by the Board of Education concerning the internal operation of the schools.
4. The Superintendent of Schools will prepare those Administrative Regulations that he/she deems necessary to implement the Policies of the Board of Education and will issue them subsequent to Board of Education approval.
5. The Superintendent of Schools is responsible in the execution of his/her duties to the Board of Education.
6. Procedures for evaluating the performance of the Superintendent of Schools are described in Policy 9720.
