The Board recognizes the advantages of utilizing members of the community as resources in the schools to:

- assist employees in providing more individualization and enrichment of instruction;
- build an understanding of school programs among interested citizens, thus stimulating widespread involvement in the total educational process;
- strengthen school/community relations through positive participation.

1. The Board of Education will encourage teachers to use knowledgeable local citizens for the enrichment of all phases of the educational program.
2. School personnel will be responsible at all times for the activities or actions of volunteers invited to augment our program.
3. The Superintendent will have supervisory control over all aspects of citizen volunteer programs aimed at assisting school personnel. The Superintendent will be empowered to dissolve or change the scope of the volunteer's assignment as deemed appropriate.
