To provide the best education possible to students within the limits of the resources available, the Board of Education should:

1. request adequate local funds for the operation of the school district. The amount of the local financial support requested, when added to state and federal aid and revenue from all other sources, shall yield sufficient revenue to meet the total expenses of the school district;
2. consider all available state funds to which the district is entitled by law or through state regulations to support the programs that the district seeks to offer; and
3. consider all federal funds that are available providing there is a specific need for them and the local funds that are required to support the particular programs of the district are available.
